- 5 SECTION 1. Section 5, Article 42.22, Code of Criminal
- 6 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 5. PERSONS WHO MAY FILE. (a) In a criminal case in
- 8 which a defendant is ordered to pay fines or costs, the attorney
- 9 representing the state [The following persons] may file an
- 10 affidavit to perfect a restitution lien[+
- 11 [(1) the attorney representing the state in a criminal
- 12 case in which a victim is determined by the court to be entitled to
- 13 restitution or in which a defendant is ordered to pay fines or
- 14 costs; or
- 15 [(2) a victim in a criminal case determined by the
- 16 court to be entitled to restitution].
- 17 (b) In a criminal case in which a victim is determined by the
- 18 court to be entitled to restitution, the clerk of the court, not
- 19 <u>later than the 30th day after the date the court enters the order to</u>
- 20 make restitution, shall file an affidavit to perfect a restitution
- 21 lien.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
