1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the course levels offered by the University of
1-9 Houston-Clear Lake.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 111.83, Education Code, is amended to
1-12 read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 111.83. ROLE AND SCOPE. [~~(a)~~] The university shall
1-14 [~~be organized to~~] offer undergraduate [~~only junior, senior,~~] and
1-15 graduate [~~graduate-level~~] programs.

1-16 [~~(b) The university may enroll a student who has
1-17 successfully completed at least 30 semester credit hours of course
1-18 work at a public or private institution of higher education and who
1-19 is concurrently enrolled in another public or private institution
1-20 of higher education.~~]

1-21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
1-22 111.83, Education Code, applies beginning with course levels that
1-23 may be offered by the University of Houston-Clear Lake for the
1-24 2012-2013 academic year.

1-25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
