5	SECTION 1. Section 382.0215, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsections (b-1) and (e-1) to read as follows:
7	(b-1) After receiving a report of an emissions event under
8	Subsection (b)(2), the commission shall provide notice of the event
9	to officials who represent the area in which the event occurred,
10	including:
11	(1) each state senator;
12	(2) each state representative;
13	(3) the county commissioners court; and
14	(4) if applicable, the mayor or other presiding
15	officer of any affected municipality.
16	(e-1) The commission shall maintain a list of emissions
17	events on the commission's Internet website that is easily
18	accessible by the public and that includes information on emissions
19	events that have occurred in the preceding 12 weeks. The
20	information must include:
21	(1) the name of the regulated entity;
22	(2) each air contaminant emitted;
23	(3) the location of the emissions event; and
24	(4) the date and duration of the event.
