- 5 SECTION 1. Section 402.0212, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsections (d), (e),
- 7 and (f) to read as follows:
- 8 (b) An invoice submitted to a state agency under a contract
- 9 for legal services as described by Subsection (a) must be reviewed
- 10 by the attorney general to determine whether the invoice is
- 11 eligible for payment.
- 12 (c) An attorney or law firm must pay an administrative fee
- 13 to the attorney general for the review described in Subsection (b)
- 14 when entering into a contract to provide legal services to a state
- 15 agency.

- 16 (d) For purposes of this section, the functions of a hearing
- 17 examiner, administrative law judge, or other quasi-judicial
- 18 officer are not considered legal services.
- 19 $\underline{\text{(e)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(e)}}{\text{(c)}}$] This section shall not apply to the Texas Turnpike
- 20 Authority division of the Texas Department of Transportation.
- 21 <u>(f) The attorney general may adopt rules as necessary to</u>
- 22 implement and administer this section.
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 24 a contract for legal services between a state agency and a private

- 1 attorney or law firm entered into on or after the effective date of
- 2 this Act. A contract for legal services between a state agency and
- 3 a private attorney or law firm entered into before the effective
- 4 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the
- 5 contract was entered into, and the former law is continued in effect
- 6 for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
