A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to categories of information presumed to be public and 3 certain exceptions from required disclosure under the public 4 information law.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 552.022, Government Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:

CATEGORIES OF PUBLIC INFORMATION; EXAMPLES. 9 (a) Without limiting the amount or kind of information that is 10 public information under this chapter, the following categories of 11 information are public information and not excepted from required 12 disclosure <u>unless made confidential</u> under this chapter <u>or</u> [unless 13 they are expressly confidential under] other law:

(1) a completed report, audit, evaluation, or investigation made of, for, or by a governmental body, except as provided by Section 552.108;

17 (2) the name, sex, ethnicity, salary, title, <u>date of</u> 18 <u>birth</u>, and dates of employment of each employee and officer of a 19 governmental body;

(3) information in an account, voucher, or contract
relating to the receipt or expenditure of public or other funds by a
governmental body;

(4) the name of each official and the final record of
voting on all proceedings in a governmental body;

1 (5) all working papers, research material, and 2 information used to estimate the need for or expenditure of public 3 funds or taxes by a governmental body, on completion of the 4 estimate;

5 (6) the name, place of business, and the name of the 6 municipality to which local sales and use taxes are credited, if 7 any, for the named person, of a person reporting or paying sales and 8 use taxes under Chapter 151, Tax Code;

9 (7) a description of an agency's central and field 10 organizations, including:

(A) the established places at which the public may obtain information, submit information or requests, or obtain decisions;

14 (B) the employees from whom the public may obtain
15 information, submit information or requests, or obtain decisions;

16 (C) in the case of a uniformed service, the 17 members from whom the public may obtain information, submit 18 information or requests, or obtain decisions; and

(D) the methods by which the public may obtaininformation, submit information or requests, or obtain decisions;

(8) a statement of the general course and method by which an agency's functions are channeled and determined, including the nature and requirements of all formal and informal policies and procedures;

(9) a rule of procedure, a description of forms
available or the places at which forms may be obtained, and
instructions relating to the scope and content of all papers,

1 reports, or examinations;

2 (10) a substantive rule of general applicability
3 adopted or issued by an agency as authorized by law, and a statement
4 of general policy or interpretation of general applicability
5 formulated and adopted by an agency;

6 (11) each amendment, revision, or repeal of
7 information described by Subdivisions (7)-(10);

8 (12) final opinions, including concurring and 9 dissenting opinions, and orders issued in the adjudication of 10 cases;

11 (13) a policy statement or interpretation that has 12 been adopted or issued by an agency;

13 (14) administrative staff manuals and instructions to 14 staff that affect a member of the public;

15 (15) information regarded as open to the public under 16 an agency's policies;

17 (16) information that is in a bill for attorney's fees18 and that is not privileged under the attorney-client privilege;

19 (17) information that is also contained in a public20 court record; and

(18) a settlement agreement to which a governmentalbody is a party.

(b) A court in this state may not order a governmental body or an officer for public information to withhold from public inspection any category of public information described by Subsection (a) or to not produce the category of public information for inspection or duplication, unless the category of information

SECTION 36. The change in law made by this Act to Sections 552.022 and 552.1235, Government Code, applies only to a request for information that is received by a governmental body or an officer for public information on or after the effective date of this Act. A request for information that was received before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the request was received, and the former law is continued in

1 effect for that purpose.

2 SECTION 37. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
