- 4 justice court shall collect a jury fee of \$25 under Section 51.604,
- 5 Government Code.
- 6 SECTION 7. Section 51.604, Government Code, as amended by
- 7 this Act, applies only to a jury fee for a civil case filed on or
- 8 after January 1, 2012. A jury fee for a civil case filed before that
- 9 date is governed by the law in effect on the date the case was filed,
- 10 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 11 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
