1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the entities eligible to make purchases using the
1-9 cooperative purchasing program administered by the comptroller.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 2155.202, Government Code, is amended to
1-12 read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 2155.202. MENTAL HEALTH AND MENTAL RETARDATION
1-14 COMMUNITY CENTERS; ASSISTANCE ORGANIZATIONS; CHILD-CARE PROVIDERS.
1-15 The following entities may purchase goods and services through the
1-16 comptroller:

1-17 (1) a [A] community center for mental health and
1-18 mental retardation services that receives state grants-in-aid
1-19 under Subchapter B, Chapter 534, Health and Safety Code;

1-20 (2) [~~and~~] an assistance organization as defined by
1-21 Section 2175.001 that receives state funds; and

1-22 (3) a child-care provider that meets the Texas Rising
1-23 Star Provider criteria described by Texas Workforce Commission
1-24 rules [~~may purchase goods and services through the commission~~].

1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
