10	licensed to carry under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code;
11	<u>and</u>
12	(2) attending a school board meeting in an official
13	<pre>capacity as:</pre>
14	(A) a member of the school board; or
15	(B) the superintendent of the school governed by
16	the school board.
17	SECTION 2. Section 46.035, Penal Code, is amended by adding
18	Subsection (1) to read as follows:
19	(1) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (c) that
20	at the time of the commission of the offense the actor was attending
21	a school board meeting in an official capacity as:
22	(1) a member of the school board; or
23	(2) the superintendent of the school governed by the
24	school board.

- 1 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 2 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 3 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 4 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 5 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 6 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 7 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
