- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 130.008(c), Education Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (c) The contact hours attributable to the enrollment of a
- 9 high school student in a course offered for joint high school and
- 10 junior college credit under this section, excluding a course for
- 11 which the student attending high school may receive course credit
- 12 toward the physical education curriculum requirement under Section
- 13 28.002(a)(2)(C), shall be included in the contact hours used to
- 14 determine the junior college's proportionate share of the state
- 15 money appropriated and distributed to public junior colleges under
- 16 Sections 130.003 and 130.0031, even if the junior college waives
- 17 all or part of the tuition or fees for the student under Subsection
- 18 (b).
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with funding for the
- 20 2011 fall semester.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
