- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 411.1952 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 411.1952. WAIVER OF FEES FOR CERTAIN ATTORNEYS.
- 9 Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter, the
- 10 department shall waive any fee required for the issuance of an
- 11 original, duplicate, modified, or renewed license under this
- 12 subchapter if the applicant for the license is a United States
- 13 <u>attorney or an assistant United States attorney.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to an applicant for an original, duplicate, modified, or renewed
- 16 license under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, as
- 17 amended by this Act, who submits the application on or after the
- 18 effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
