- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 5.236(a), Water Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (a) If the executive director acquires information that
- 8 confirms that a potential public health hazard exists because
- 9 usable groundwater has been or is being contaminated, the executive
- 10 director, not later than the 30th day after the date on which the
- 11 executive director acquires the information confirming
- 12 contamination, shall give written notice of the contamination to
- 13 the following persons:
- 14 (1) the county judge and the county health officer, if
- 15 any, in each county in which the contamination has occurred or is
- 16 occurring;
- 17 (2) any person under the commission's jurisdiction who
- 18 is suspected of contributing to the contamination; [and]
- 19 (3) any other state agency with jurisdiction over any
- 20 person who is suspected of contributing to the contamination; and
- 21 (4) a groundwater conservation district, if the
- 22 contamination has occurred or is occurring in the jurisdiction of
- 23 the district.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to groundwater

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- 1 contamination about which the executive director of the Texas
- 2 Commission on Environmental Quality acquires information on or
- B after the effective date of this Act. Groundwater contamination
- 4 about which the executive director of the Texas Commission on
- 5 Environmental Quality acquires information before the effective
- 6 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 7 information is acquired, and the former law is continued in effect
- 8 for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
