- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subdivision (5), Section 135.011, Education
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (5) "Campus" means a [residential] unit of the system
- 7 that grants associate degrees and certificates.
- 8 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 135.02, Education Code,
- 9 is amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) The Texas State Technical College System is composed of:
- 11 (1) a system office located in the city of Waco in
- 12 McLennan County;
- 13 (2) a campus located in the city of Harlingen in
- 14 Cameron County;
- 15 (3) a campus serving West Texas that operates as a
- 16 collective unit of strategically positioned permanent locations
- 17 [located] in the city of Sweetwater in Nolan County, the city of
- 18 Abilene in Taylor County, the city of Brownwood in Brown County, and
- 19 the city of Breckenridge in Stephens County;
- 20 (4) a campus located in the city of Marshall in
- 21 Harrison County;
- 22 (5) a campus located in the city of Waco in McLennan

- 24 (6) [extension centers in the city of Brownwood in

- 1 Brown County and the city of Abilene in Taylor County and an
- 2 extension program offered through a rural technology center in the
- 3 city of Breckenridge in Stephens County; and
- 4 $[\frac{(7) \text{ other}}{}]$ campuses assigned to the system from time
- 5 to time by specific legislative Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
