1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the Texas State Technical College System.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Subdivision (5), Section 135.011, Education  
1-11 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-12 (5) "Campus" means a ~~[residential]~~ unit of the system  
1-13 that grants associate degrees and certificates.

1-14 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 135.02, Education Code,  
1-15 is amended to read as follows:

1-16 (a) The Texas State Technical College System is composed of:

1-17 (1) a system office located in the city of Waco in  
1-18 McLennan County;

1-19 (2) a campus located in the city of Harlingen in  
1-20 Cameron County;

1-21 (3) a campus serving West Texas that operates as a  
1-22 collective unit of strategically positioned permanent locations  
1-23 [located] in the city of Sweetwater in Nolan County, the city of  
1-24 Abilene in Taylor County, the city of Brownwood in Brown County, and  
1-25 the city of Breckenridge in Stephens County;

1-26 (4) a campus located in the city of Marshall in  
1-27 Harrison County;

1-28 (5) a campus located in the city of Waco in McLennan  
1-29 County; and

1-30 (6) ~~[extension centers in the city of Brownwood in~~  
1-31 ~~Brown County and the city of Abilene in Taylor County and an~~  
1-32 ~~extension program offered through a rural technology center in the~~  
1-33 ~~city of Breckenridge in Stephens County, and~~

1-34 ~~[(7) other]~~ campuses assigned to the system from time  
1-35 to time by specific legislative Act.

1-36 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
