## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to the punishment for the offense of evading arrest or 2 3 detention. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subsections (b) and (c), Section 38.04, Penal 5 6 Code, are amended to read as follows: An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor, 7 (b) except that the offense is: 8 (1) a state jail felony if: 9 10 (A) the actor has been previously convicted under this section; or 11 12 (B) the actor uses a vehicle or watercraft while 13 the actor is in flight and the actor has not been previously convicted under this section; 14 15 (2) a felony of the third degree if: (A) the actor uses a vehicle or watercraft while 16 the actor is in flight and the actor has been previously convicted 17 under this section; or 18 (B) another suffers serious bodily injury as a 19 direct result of an attempt by the officer from whom the actor is 20 21 fleeing to apprehend the actor while the actor is in flight; or 22 (3) a felony of the second degree if another suffers 23 death as a direct result of an attempt by the officer from whom the actor is fleeing to apprehend the actor while the actor is in 24

3	(1) "Vehicle"[ <del>, "vehicle"</del> ] has the meaning assigned by
4	Section 541.201, Transportation Code.
5	(2) "Watercraft" has the meaning assigned by Section
6	49.01.
7	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
8	to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
9	An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
10	covered by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
11	and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
12	purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
13	effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
14	before that date.
15	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
