A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the establishment of an interagency council for addressing disproportionality. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Title 1, Human Resources Code, is amended by 5 adding Chapter 2 to read as follows: 6 CHAPTER 2. INTERAGENCY COUNCIL FOR ADDRESSING DISPROPORTIONALITY 7 Sec. 2.001. INTERAGENCY COUNCIL FOR ADDRESSING 8 DISPROPORTIONALITY. The Interagency Council for Addressing 9 Disproportionality is established to: 10 11 (1) examine the level of disproportionate involvement 12 of children who are members of a racial or ethnic minority group at each stage in the juvenile justice, child welfare, education, and 13 mental health systems, including: 14 (A) the points of entry; 15 16 (B) each point at which a treatment decision is 17 made; and 18 (C) the outcomes for the children exiting the 19 systems; and 20 (2) make recommendations to reduce the involvement of 21 the children in the systems. Sec. 2.002. COMPOSITION OF COUNCIL; MEETINGS. (a) The 22 23 council consists of: 24 (1) one representative from each of the following

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1	agencies appointed by the executive director or commissioner of
2	each agency:
3	(A) the Texas Education Agency;
4	(B) the Center for Elimination of
5	Disproportionality and Disparities within the Health and Human
6	Services Commission;
7	(C) the Department of Assistive and
8	Rehabilitative Services;
9	(D) the Department of Aging and Disability
10	<u>Services;</u>
11	(E) the Department of State Health Services;
12	(F) the Department of Family and Protective
13	Services;
14	(G) the Texas Youth Commission; and
15	(H) the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission; and
16	(2) one representative of the office of the attorney
17	general appointed by the attorney general.
18	(b) A representative of an agency appointed to the council
19	must have an overall understanding of the agency's mission and
20	purpose and substantial experience and expertise relating to the
21	administration of the agency's policies, programs, and activities.
22	(c) The representative from the Center for Elimination of
23	Disproportionality and Disparities within the Health and Human
24	Services Commission serves as the presiding officer of the council.
25	(d) The council shall meet at least quarterly.
26	Sec. 2.003. COUNCIL DUTIES. The council's duties include:
27	(1) reviewing the delivery of public and private child

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1	outcomes for children who are members of a racial or ethnic minority
2	group who are served by the systems; and
3	(9) preparing a report consisting of the council's
4	findings and recommendations, and the presentation of an
5	implementation plan to address disproportionate representation of
6	children who are members of a racial or ethnic minority group in the
7	use of children's services.
8	Sec. 2.004. COUNCIL REPORT. Not later than December 1,
9	2012, the council shall prepare and submit to the lieutenant
10	governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the
11	legislature a report containing the council's findings and
12	recommendations for addressing the disproportionate representation
13	of children who are members of a racial or ethnic minority group in
14	the use of children's services and the council's recommendation as
15	to whether to continue the council.
16	Sec. 2.005. EXPIRATION OF CHAPTER. This chapter expires
17	December 1, 2013.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
