A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the period during which a motion for a new trial in a

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 45.037, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 45.037. MOTION FOR NEW TRIAL. A motion for a new trial
- 8 must be made within five days [one day] after the rendition of
- 9 judgment and sentence, and not afterward.
- 10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to a judgment in a criminal proceeding entered on or after the
- 12 effective date of this Act. A judgment in a criminal proceeding
- 13 entered before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 14 in effect on the date the judgment was entered, and the former law
- 15 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
