- 8 RALPH HALL, [AND] POST LAKE, AND LOWER BOIS D'ARC CREEK RESERVOIR
- 9 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 231.131, Local
- 10 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The legislature finds that:
- 12 (1) the areas that surround Lake Alan Henry, Lake
- 13 Cooper, Lake Ralph Hall, [and] Post Lake, and Lower Bois d'Arc Creek
- 14 Reservoir are or will be frequented for recreational purposes by
- 15 residents from every part of the state;
- 16 (2) development in the area, including the
- 17 construction of on-site water treatment systems or other sources of
- 18 contamination, may impact the water quality in the lakes and the
- 19 <u>reservoir;</u>
- 20 <u>(3)</u> orderly development and use of the area is of
- 21 concern to the entire state; and
- (4) $\left[\frac{(3)}{(3)}\right]$ buildings in the area that will be
- 23 frequented for resort or recreational purposes will tend to become
- 24 congested and to be used in ways that interfere with the proper use

- 1 of the area as a place of recreation to the detriment of the public
- 2 health, safety, morals, and general welfare.
- 3 SECTION 3. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 231.132, Local
- 4 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) This subchapter applies to:
- 6 (1) those parts of Garza County located within three
- 7 miles of the high water marks established for Lake Alan Henry and
- 8 Post Lake except land located in Garza County and owned by the White
- 9 River Municipal Water District;
- 10 (2) those parts of Kent County located within three
- 11 miles of the high water marks established for Lake Alan Henry;
- 12 (3) the area within 10,000 feet of where the shoreline
- 13 of Lake Cooper would be if the lake were filled to its storage
- 14 capacity; [and]
- 15 (4) the area within 5,000 feet of where the shoreline
- 16 of Lake Ralph Hall would be if the lake were filled to its storage
- 17 capacity; and
- 18 (5) the area within 5,000 feet of where the shoreline
- 19 of the Lower Bois d'Arc Creek Reservoir would be if the reservoir
- 20 were filled to its storage capacity.
- 21 (b) The areas described by Subsection (a) are subject to
- 22 regulation under this subchapter regardless of whether the
- 23 construction of an affected lake or reservoir is complete.
- SECTION 4. Subsection (c), Section 231.132, Local
- 25 Government Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
