A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the use of certain discipline management practices or
- 3 behavior management techniques by peace officers employed or
- 4 commissioned by school districts.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 37.0021, Education Code,
- 7 is amended by adding Subdivision (4) to read as follows:
- 8 (4) "Law enforcement duties" means activities of a
- 9 peace officer relating to the investigation and enforcement of
- 10 state criminal laws and other duties authorized by the Code of
- 11 Criminal Procedure.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 37.0021, Education Code, is amended by
- 13 amending Subsection (g) and adding Subsections (h) and (i) to read
- 14 as follows:
- 15 (g) This section and any rules or procedures adopted under
- 16 this section do not apply to:
- 17 (1) a peace officer [while] performing law enforcement
- 18 duties, except as provided by Subsection (i);
- 19 (2) juvenile probation, detention, or corrections
- 20 personnel; or
- 21 (3) an educational services provider with whom a
- 22 student is placed by a judicial authority, unless the services are
- 23 provided in an educational program of a school district.
- (h) This section and any rules or procedures adopted under

- 1 this section apply to a peace officer only if the peace officer:
- 2 (1) is employed or commissioned by a school district;
- 3 <u>or</u>
- 4 (2) provides, as a school resource officer, a regular
- 5 police presence on a school district campus under a memorandum of
- 6 <u>understanding between the district and a local law enforcement</u>
- 7 agency.
- 8 <u>(i) A school district shall report electronically to the</u>
- 9 agency, in accordance with standards provided by commissioner rule,
- 10 information relating to the use of restraint by a peace officer
- 11 performing law enforcement duties on school property or during a
- 12 school-sponsored or school-related activity. A report submitted
- 13 under this subsection must be consistent with the requirements
- 14 adopted by commissioner rule for reporting the use of restraint
- 15 <u>involving students with disabilities.</u>
- 16 SECTION 3. The commissioner of education shall adopt rules
- 17 as provided by Subsection (i), Section 37.0021, Education Code, as
- 18 added by this Act, as soon as practicable after the effective date
- 19 of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
