5	SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 843, Insurance Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 843.3115 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 843.3115. CONTRACTS WITH DENTISTS. (a) In this
8	section, "covered service" means a dental care service for which
9	reimbursement is available under an enrollee's health care plan
10	contract, or for which reimbursement is available subject to a
11	contractual limitation, including:
12	(1) a deductible;
13	(2) a copayment;
14	(3) coinsurance;
15	(4) a waiting period;
16	(5) an annual or lifetime maximum limit;
17	(6) a frequency limitation; or
18	(7) an alternative benefit payment.
19	(b) A contract between a health maintenance organization
20	and a dentist may not limit the fee the dentist may charge for a
21	service that is not a covered service.
22	SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 1451, Insurance Code, is
23	amended by adding Section 1451.2065 to read as follows:
24	Sec. 1451.2065. CONTRACTS WITH DENTISTS. (a) In this

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- 1 section, "covered service" means a dental care service for which
- 2 reimbursement is available under a patient's employee benefit plan
- 3 or health insurance policy, or for which reimbursement is available
- 4 subject to a contractual limitation, including:
- 5 (1) a deductible;
- 6 <u>(2) a copayment;</u>
- 7 <u>(3) coinsurance;</u>
- 8 <u>(4) a waiting period;</u>
- 9 (5) an annual or lifetime maximum limit;
- 10 (6) a frequency limitation; or
- 11 (7) an alternative benefit payment.
- 12 (b) A contract between an insurer and a dentist may not
- 13 limit the fee the dentist may charge for a service that is not a
- 14 covered service.
- 15 SECTION 3. Sections 843.3115 and 1451.2065, Insurance Code,
- 16 as added by this Act, apply only to a contract entered into or
- 17 renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A contract
- 18 entered into or renewed before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 20 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
