- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 41, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 41.014 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 41.014. DAMAGES FOR CONSTRUCTION DEFECT. (a) In this
- 8 section, "construction defect" means a deficiency in the
- 9 construction or repair of an improvement to real property.
- 10 (b) This section applies only to a claim against a person
- 11 who constructed or repaired an improvement to real property to
- 12 recover the cost of curing a construction defect.
- 13 (c) This section applies to a claim regardless of whether
- 14 the claim is asserted by a person who contracted for the
- 15 construction or repair.
- 16 (d) The amount of actual damages for the cost to cure a
- 17 construction defect that might otherwise be awarded in a claim
- 18 subject to this section is reduced by 10 percent for each
- 19 <u>anniversary of the date of substantial completion of the</u>
- 20 construction or repair that occurs before the date the action
- 21 asserting the claim is filed. An award of exemplary damages,
- 22 <u>multiplied damages</u>, or other damages that is computed on the basis
- 23 of the amount awarded as damages for the cost to cure the
- 24 construction defect must reflect any reduction of that amount under

- 2 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 3 to construction or repair of an improvement to real property
- 4 commenced on or after the effective date of this Act under a
- 5 contract entered into on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 6 Construction or repair of an improvement to real property under a
- 7 contract entered into before the effective date of this Act is
- 8 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 9 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
