BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 186, Acts of the 50th Legislature,
Regular Session, 1947, is amended by adding Section 11 to read as

- 6 Regular Session, 1947, is amended by adding Section 11 to read as 7 follows:
- 8 <u>Sec. 11. (a) In this section, "economic development</u>
  9 program" includes a program designed to:
- 10 (1) encourage economic diversification;

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- (2) contribute to the health and development of a community to improve the attractiveness of the community to public and private enterprises; or
- 14 (3) improve the quality or quantity of services
  15 essential for the development of viable communities and economic
  16 growth, including services related to education, transportation,
  17 public safety, recreation, health care, training, community
  18 planning, or employment.
- (b) The District may sponsor and participate in an economic development program intended to strengthen the economic base and further the economic development of this state. A determination by the Board of Directors that an economic development program is intended and expected to accomplish the program's stated purposes is conclusive with respect to whether the program serves the

purposes of this section. 1 2 (c) An economic development program must be within: 3 (1) the territorial boundaries of the District; or 4 (2) the District's water service area. An economic development program may be established only 5 by formal action of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors 6 7 shall: (1) establish the goals of the program; 8 9 (2) impose requirements on persons participating in or receiving a benefit from the program; and 10 11 (3) provide restrictions, procedures, and budget limits the Board of Directors determines are necessary to ensure 12 13 that the governmental purposes of this section and the program are 14 achieved. 15 (e) An economic development program may involve the 16 granting or lending of money, services, or property to a person engaged in an economic development activity. 17 18 (f) The District may: (1) employ staff and spend its resources, other than 19 20 money received from an ad valorem tax or a general appropriation, to further an economic development program; and 21 22 (2) apply for and receive money, grants, or other 23 assistance from any source to implement an economic development 24 program. 25 (g) The District and any public or private person may enter into an agreement with respect to an economic development program. 26

(h) If the District proposes to provide scholarships,

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- 1 grants, loans, or financial assistance to a public fire-fighting
- 2 organization, the District shall adopt guidelines for determining:
- 3 (1) eligibility for the assistance;
- 4 (2) the amount of any loan, grant, or other assistance
- 5 the District may provide; and
- 6 (3) the types of equipment, facilities, education, or
- 7 training for which the assistance may be used.
- 8 SECTION 2. The legislature finds that the economic
- 9 development programs authorized by Section 11, Chapter 186, Acts of
- 10 the 50th Legislature, Regular Session, 1947, as added by this Act,
- 11 are a specific public purpose and governmental function of the
- 12 Lavaca-Navidad River Authority in accordance with:
- 13 (1) Section 52-a, Article III, Texas Constitution; and
- 14 (2) Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
