AN ACT

2 relating to jurisdiction in certain proceedings brought by the

3 attorney general with respect to charitable trusts.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 123.005, Property Code, is amended to

6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 123.005. BREACH OF FIDUCIARY DUTY: VENUE;

8 <u>JURISDICTION</u>. (a) Venue in a proceeding brought by the attorney

9 general alleging breach of a fiduciary duty by a charitable entity

10 or a fiduciary or managerial agent of a charitable trust shall be a

11 court of competent jurisdiction in Travis County or in the county

12 where the defendant resides or has its principal office. To the

13 extent of a conflict between this subsection and any provision of

14 the Texas Probate Code providing for venue of a proceeding brought

15 with respect to a charitable trust created by a will that has been

16 admitted to probate, this subsection controls.

17 (b) A statutory probate court of Travis County has

18 concurrent jurisdiction with any other court on which jurisdiction

19 is conferred by Section 4A, Texas Probate Code, in a proceeding

20 brought by the attorney general alleging breach of a fiduciary duty

21 with respect to a charitable trust created by a will that has been

22 <u>admitted to probate.</u>

23 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

24 to a proceeding commenced on or after the effective date of this

- 1 Act. A proceeding commenced before the effective date of this Act
- 2 is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective
- 3 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 4 purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
