## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to limits on the size of prekindergarten classes in public
- 3 schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 25.112(a), (d), and (e), Education
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as otherwise authorized by this section, a school
- 8 district may not enroll more than <u>18 students in a prekindergarten</u>
- 9 class or 22 students in a kindergarten, first, second, third, or
- 10 fourth grade class. A limit imposed by this subsection [That
- 11 limitation does not apply during:
- 12 (1) any 12-week period of the school year selected by
- 13 the district, in the case of a district whose average daily
- 14 attendance is adjusted under Section 42.005(c); or
- 15 (2) the last 12 weeks of any school year in the case of
- 16 any other district.
- 17 (d) On application of a school district, the commissioner
- 18 may except the district from  $\underline{a}$  [the] limit  $\underline{imposed}$  by  $[\underline{in}]$
- 19 Subsection (a) if the commissioner finds the limit works an undue
- 20 hardship on the district. An exception expires at the end of the
- 21 school year for which it is granted.
- (e) A school district seeking an exception under Subsection
- 23 (d) shall notify the commissioner and apply for the exception not
- 24 later than the later of:

- 1 (1) October 1; or
- 2 (2) the 30th day after the first school day the
- 3 district exceeds  $\underline{a}$  [the] limit  $\underline{imposed}$  by  $[\underline{in}]$  Subsection (a).
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 25.113(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) A campus or district that is granted an exception under
- 7 Section 25.112(d) from class size limits shall provide written
- 8 notice of the exception to the parent of or person standing in
- 9 parental relation to each student affected by the exception. The
- 10 notice must be in conspicuous bold or underlined print and:
- 11 (1) specify the class for which an exception from  $\underline{a}$
- 12 [the] limit imposed by Section 25.112(a) was granted;
- 13 (2) state the number of children in the class for which
- 14 the exception was granted; and
- 15 (3) be included in a regular mailing or other
- 16 communication from the campus or district, such as information sent
- 17 home with students.
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 19 school year.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect August 1, 2015.
