- 2 governmental body receives the written modified request.
- 3 SECTION 4. Section 552.301, Government Code, is amended by
- 4 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 5 (a-1) For the purposes of this subchapter, if a governmental
- 6 body receives a written request by the United States mail and cannot
- 7 adequately establish the actual date on which the governmental body
- 8 received the request, the written request is considered to have
- 9 been received by the governmental body on the third business day
- 10 after the date of the postmark on a properly addressed request.
- 11 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections
- 12 552.263 and 552.301, Government Code, apply only to a request for
- 13 information that is received by a governmental body or an officer
- 14 for public information on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 15 A request for information that was received before the effective
- 16 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 17 request was received, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 18 that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
