The fee may be used only to offset the costs of providing additional county services resulting from fireworks sales, 10 including firefighting services, litter abatement services, and 11 traffic management services. 12 SECTION 2. Section 42.01(a), Penal Code, is amended to read 13 14 as follows: (a) A person commits an offense if he intentionally or 15 16 knowingly: (1) uses abusive, indecent, profane, or vulgar 17 language in a public place, and the language by its very utterance 18 tends to incite an immediate breach of the peace; 19 20 (2) makes an offensive gesture or display in a public place, and the gesture or display tends to incite an immediate 21 breach of the peace; 22 23 (3) creates, by chemical means, a noxious and 24 unreasonable odor in a public place;

(4) abuses or threatens a person in a public place in
 an obviously offensive manner;

3 (5) makes unreasonable noise in a public place other 4 than a sport shooting range, as defined by Section 250.001, Local 5 Government Code, or in or near a private residence that he has no 6 right to occupy;

(6) fights with another in a public place;

8 (7) discharges a firearm in a public place other than a 9 public road or a sport shooting range, as defined by Section 10 250.001, Local Government Code;

11 (8) displays a firearm or other deadly weapon in a 12 public place in a manner calculated to alarm;

13 (9) discharges a firearm on or across a public road;

14 (10) exposes his anus or genitals in a public place and 15 is reckless about whether another may be present who will be 16 offended or alarmed by his act; [or]

(11) for a lewd or unlawful purpose:

18 (A) enters on the property of another and looks
19 into a dwelling on the property through any window or other opening
20 in the dwelling;

(B) while on the premises of a hotel or comparable establishment, looks into a guest room not the person's own through a window or other opening in the room; or

(C) while on the premises of a public place,
looks into an area such as a restroom or shower stall or changing or
dressing room that is designed to provide privacy to a person using
the area; or
