1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the exemption of certain property from municipal  
1-9 drainage service charges and from related ordinances, resolutions,  
1-10 and rules.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subsection (e), Section 552.053, Local  
1-13 Government Code, as added by Chapters 278 (S.B. 874) and 539 (S.B.  
1-14 1522), Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, is  
1-15 reenacted and amended to read as follows:

1-16 (e) The following property is exempt from drainage charges  
1-17 under Section 552.047 and all ordinances, resolutions, and rules  
1-18 adopted under this subchapter:

1-19 (1) property owned by a county in which a municipality  
1-20 described by Section 552.044(8)(A) is located;

1-21 (2) property owned by a school district located wholly  
1-22 or partly in a municipality described by Section 552.044(8)(A); and

1-23 (3) property owned by a municipal housing authority of  
1-24 a municipality described by Section 552.044(8)(A).

1-25 SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails  
1-26 over another Act of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011,  
1-27 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted  
1-28 codes.

1-29 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
