- 14 store solar-generated energy for use in heating or cooling or in the
- 15 production of power.

- 16 (b) This chapter applies only to a contract for construction
- 17 of a new home in a subdivision that contains more than 50 lots on
- 18 which the builder has built or is offering to build new homes.
- 19 (c) A builder who enters into a contract to which this
- 20 chapter applies shall offer the home buyer an option to install a
- 21 solar energy device on the home for heating or cooling or for the
- 22 production of power.
- 23 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to a contract for new home construction entered into on or after the

- 1 effective date of this Act. A contract entered into before the
- 2 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect
- 3 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 4 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
