## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to changing the name of the Railroad Commission of Texas to
- 3 the Texas Oil and Gas Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 81, Natural Resources
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 81. TEXAS OIL AND GAS [RAILROAD] COMMISSION [OF TEXAS]
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 81.001, Natural Resources Code, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 81.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 11 (1) "Commission" means the Texas Oil and Gas
- 12 [Railroad] Commission [of Texas].
- 13 (2) "Commissioner" means any member of the <u>Texas Oil</u>
- 14 and Gas [Railroad] Commission [of Texas].
- 15 SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 81, Natural Resources
- 16 Code, is amended by adding Section 81.003 to read as follows:
- Sec. 81.003. TEXAS OIL AND GAS COMMISSION. (a) The
- 18 Railroad Commission of Texas is renamed the Texas Oil and Gas
- 19 Commission.
- 20 (b) A reference in law to the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 21 means the Texas Oil and Gas Commission.
- 22 SECTION 4. (a) Effective January 1, 2012:
- 23 (1) the name of the Railroad Commission of Texas is
- 24 changed to the Texas Oil and Gas Commission, and all powers, duties,

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- 1 rights, and obligations of the Railroad Commission of Texas are the
- 2 powers, duties, rights, and obligations of the Texas Oil and Gas
- 3 Commission;
- 4 (2) a member of the Railroad Commission of Texas is a
- 5 member of the Texas Oil and Gas Commission; and
- 6 (3) any appropriation to the Railroad Commission of
- 7 Texas is an appropriation to the Texas Oil and Gas Commission.
- 8 (b) Effective January 1, 2012, a reference in law to the
- 9 Railroad Commission of Texas is a reference to the Texas Oil and Gas
- 10 Commission.
- 11 (c) The Texas Oil and Gas Commission is the successor to the
- 12 Railroad Commission of Texas in all respects. All personnel,
- 13 equipment, data, documents, facilities, contracts, items, other
- 14 property, rules, decisions, and proceedings of or involving the
- 15 Railroad Commission of Texas are unaffected by the change in the
- 16 name of the agency.
- 17 (d) The Railroad Commission of Texas shall adopt a timetable
- 18 for phasing in the change of the agency's name so as to minimize the
- 19 fiscal impact of the name change. Until January 1, 2012, to allow
- 20 for phasing in the change of the agency's name and in accordance
- 21 with the timetable established as required by this section, the
- 22 agency may perform any act authorized by law for the Railroad
- 23 Commission of Texas as the Railroad Commission of Texas or as the
- 24 Texas Oil and Gas Commission. Any act of the Railroad Commission of
- 25 Texas acting as the Texas Oil and Gas Commission on or after the
- 26 effective date of this Act and before January 1, 2012, is an act of
- 27 the Railroad Commission of Texas.

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- 1 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
