- 20 (b) Sections 101.06111, 101.06113, 101.06114, 101.06115,
- 21 101.06116, and 101.06117, Government Code, are repealed.
- SECTION 3. Subsection (b), Section 51.318, Government Code,
- 23 as amended by this Act, applies only to a request for a certified
- 24 copy of a record, judgment, order, pleading, or paper on file or of
- 25 record in the district clerk's office, including certificate and
- 26 seal, made on or after the effective date of this Act. A request
- 27 made before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in

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- 1 effect when the request was made, and the former law is continued in
- 2 effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
