5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 40, Human Resources Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 40.074 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 40.074. CHILD WELFARE ASSESSMENT TASK FORCE. (a) The
8	child welfare assessment task force is established to:
9	(1) study the assessments used by the department to
10	determine the appropriate placement, treatment, and service needs
11	for a child;
12	(2) develop a list of tools for providers to use when
13	conducting behavioral assessments of children in the child welfare
14	system; and
15	(3) develop guidelines regarding the contents of
16	assessment reports.
17	(b) The task force consists of the following members
18	appointed by the executive commissioner:
19	(1) one member from the National Association of Social
20	Workers, Texas Chapter;
21	(2) one member from the Texas Foster Family
22	Association;
23	(3) one member from the Texas Psychological

1	(4) one member who is a member of the department's
2	public-private partnership regarding foster care redesign;
3	(5) one member who receives or has received mental
4	health services as a foster child;
5	(6) one member who is an advocate for children's
6	interests in the child welfare system;
7	(7) one member who is a judge with experience working
8	with cases involving child protective services;
9	(8) one member who is a parent with experience in the
10	child welfare system; and
11	(9) three members who are clinicians with experience
12	in, and knowledge of, comprehensive assessments and training in
13	trauma informed assessment and care.
14	(c) Each member appointed to the task force must have
15	experience and expertise relating to children's behavioral health
16	and the study and prevention of child abuse and neglect.
17	(d) The task force shall elect a presiding officer by a vote
18	of the membership of the task force.
19	(e) The task force shall meet at the call of the presiding
20	officer.
21	(f) Not later than December 1, 2012, the task force shall
22	prepare and submit to the commissioner a report containing:
23	(1) a description of the activities of the task force;
24	and
25	(2) the findings and recommendations of the task
26	force, including:
27	(A) a list of tools for providers to use when

1	conducting behavioral assessments of children in the child welfare
2	system; and
3	(B) guidelines regarding the contents of
4	assessment reports.
5	(g) Not later than September 1, 2013, the department shall
6	adopt policies that incorporate the findings and recommendations of
7	the task force described by Subsection (f).
8	(h) This section expires September 1, 2014.
9	SECTION 2. The executive commissioner of the Health and
10	Human Services Commission shall make the appointments to the child
11	welfare assessment task force created by this Act not later than
12	January 1, 2012.
13	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
14	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
15	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
16	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

17 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
