S.B. No. 682

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to access to criminal history record information that  
3 relates to a person who is an applicant for appointment to an  
4 appraisal review board.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 411.1296, Government  
7 Code, is amended to read as follows:

8 Sec. 411.1296. ACCESS TO CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD  
9 INFORMATION: EMPLOYMENT BY APPRAISAL DISTRICT AND APPOINTMENT TO  
10 APPRAISAL REVIEW BOARD.

11 SECTION 2. Section 411.1296, Government Code, is amended by  
12 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as  
13 follows:

14 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), an appraisal  
15 district established by Section 6.01, Tax Code, is entitled to  
16 obtain from the department criminal history record information  
17 maintained by the department that relates to a person who is an  
18 applicant for employment by the appraisal district or for  
19 appointment to the appraisal review board for the appraisal  
20 district.

21 (c) If the members of the appraisal review board of an  
22 appraisal district are appointed by the local administrative  
23 district judge, the appraisal district may provide criminal history  
24 record information obtained under this section to the local

1 administrative district judge or to the appraisal review board  
2 commissioners appointed by the local administrative district  
3 judge.

4           SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
8 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
