1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to access to criminal history record information that
1-9 relates to a person who is an applicant for appointment to an
1-10 appraisal review board.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 411.1296, Government
1-13 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 411.1296. ACCESS TO CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD
1-15 INFORMATION: EMPLOYMENT BY APPRAISAL DISTRICT AND APPOINTMENT TO
1-16 APPRAISAL REVIEW BOARD.

1-17 SECTION 2. Section 411.1296, Government Code, is amended by
1-18 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
1-19 follows:

1-20 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), an appraisal
1-21 district established by Section 6.01, Tax Code, is entitled to
1-22 obtain from the department criminal history record information
1-23 maintained by the department that relates to a person who is an
1-24 applicant for employment by the appraisal district or for
1-25 appointment to the appraisal review board for the appraisal
1-26 district.

1-27 (c) If the members of the appraisal review board of an
1-28 appraisal district are appointed by the local administrative
1-29 district judge, the appraisal district may provide criminal history
1-30 record information obtained under this section to the local
1-31 administrative district judge or to the appraisal review board
1-32 commissioners appointed by the local administrative district
1-33 judge.

1-34 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
