A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the exemption from permitting by groundwater
- 3 conservation districts for certain water wells used for domestic,

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 36.117, Water Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) A district may not require any permit issued by the
- 9 district for:
- 10 (1) a well used solely for domestic use, or for
- 11 providing water for livestock or poultry, if the well is:
- 12 (A) located on a tract of land larger than 10
- 13 acres; and
- 14 <u>(B)</u> [that is] either drilled, completed, or
- 15 equipped so that it is incapable of producing more than 25,000
- 16 gallons of groundwater a day;
- 17 (2) the drilling of a water well used solely to supply
- 18 water for a rig that is actively engaged in drilling or exploration
- 19 operations for an oil or gas well permitted by the Railroad
- 20 Commission of Texas provided that the person holding the permit is
- 21 responsible for drilling and operating the water well and the well
- 22 is located on the same lease or field associated with the drilling
- 23 rig; or
- 24 (3) the drilling of a water well authorized under a

- 1 permit issued by the Railroad Commission of Texas under Chapter
- 2 134, Natural Resources Code, or for production from such a well to
- 3 the extent the withdrawals are required for mining activities
- 4 regardless of any subsequent use of the water.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
