	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to reporting regarding state fees by the comptroller and
3	in the general appropriations bill.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 403, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 403.0145 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 403.0145. PUBLICATION OF FEES SCHEDULE. As soon as
8	practicable after the end of each regular or special legislative
9	session, the comptroller shall publish a schedule of all revenue to
10	the state from fees authorized by statute, including statutes
11	adopted during that legislative session. For each fee, the
12	schedule must specify:
13	(1) the purpose for which the fee revenue is to be
14	used;
15	(2) if the fee has been increased during that
16	legislative session, the amount of the increase;
17	(3) into which fund the fee revenue will be deposited;
18	and
19	(4) the amount of the fee revenue that will be used for
20	budget certification.
21	SECTION 2. Section 322.008, Government Code, is amended by
22	adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
23	(b-1) For each state fee the amount of which is proposed to
24	be increased by a provision of the general appropriations bill, the

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1	general appropriations bill must set out in a separate section of
2	the bill:
3	(1) the statutory authority for the fee;
4	(2) the amount of the fee increase;
5	(3) the purpose for which the fee revenue is to be
6	used; and
7	(4) into which fund the fee revenue will be deposited.
8	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
9	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
10	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
11	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
12	Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
