- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2.005(b), Family Code, is amended to

- 9 by this state, another state, or a Canadian province that is current

- 2 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 3 to an application for a marriage license submitted to a county clerk
- 4 on or after the effective date of this Act. An application for a
- 5 marriage license submitted before the effective date of this Act is
- 6 governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and the
- 7 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
