## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a notification requirement if a public school campus or

3 open-enrollment charter school does not have a nurse assigned to

4 the campus during all instructional hours.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 38.021 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 38.021. PARENTAL NOTIFICATION CONCERNING SCHOOL
- 9 NURSES. (a) A public school, including an open-enrollment charter
- 10 school, that does not have a full-time school nurse or the
- 11 equivalent of a full-time school nurse assigned to the campus for
- 12 more than 30 consecutive instructional days during the same school
- 13 year shall provide written notice of the absence of a nurse to the
- 14 parent of or other person standing in parental relation to each
- 15 student enrolled in the school.
- 16 (b) A school has the equivalent of a full-time school nurse
- 17 under Subsection (a) if the school has one or more nurses licensed
- 18 under Chapter 301, Occupations Code, assigned to the school and
- 19 those nurses' combined assignments cover all regular student
- 20 instructional hours at a campus during the regular school day.
- 21 (c) The principal of the school shall provide the notice
- 22 required by Subsection (a) not later than the 30th instructional
- 23 day after the first day the school does not have a full-time school
- 24 nurse assigned to the campus.

- 1 (d) The school shall:
- 2 (1) make a good faith effort to ensure that the notice
- 3 required by this section is provided in a bilingual form to any
- 4 parent or other person standing in parental relation whose primary
- 5 language is not English; and
- 6 (2) retain a copy of any notice provided under this
- 7 <u>section.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 9 school year.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
