## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the inclusion of professional staff who educate
- 3 students with disabilities on district-level and campus-level
- 4 planning and decision-making committees.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsections (b) and (e), Section 11.251,
- 7 Education Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The board shall adopt a policy to establish a district-
- 9 and campus-level planning and decision-making process that will
- 10 involve the professional staff of the district, parents, and
- 11 community members in establishing and reviewing the district's and
- 12 campuses' educational plans, goals, performance objectives, and
- 13 major classroom instructional programs. The board shall establish
- 14 a procedure under which meetings are held regularly by district-
- 15 and campus-level planning and decision-making committees that
- 16 include representative professional staff, including, if
- 17 practicable, at least one representative with the primary
- 18 responsibility for educating students with disabilities, parents
- 19 of students enrolled in the district, business representatives, and
- 20 community members. The committees shall include a business
- 21 representative without regard to whether the representative
- 22 resides in the district or whether the business the person
- 23 represents is located in the district. The board, or the board's
- 24 designee, shall periodically meet with the district-level

- 1 committee to review the district-level committee's deliberations.
- 2 (e) The board shall adopt a procedure, consistent with
- 3 Section 21.407(a), for the professional staff in the district to
- 4 nominate and elect the professional staff representatives who shall
- 5 meet with the board or the board designee as required under this
- 6 section. At least two-thirds of the elected professional staff
- 7 representatives must be classroom teachers. The remaining staff
- 8 representatives shall include both campus- and district-level
- 9 professional staff members. <u>If practicable, the committee</u>
- 10 membership shall include at least one professional staff
- 11 representative with the primary responsibility for educating
- 12 <u>students with disabilities</u>. Board policy must provide procedures
- 13 for:
- 14 (1) the selection of parents to the district-level and
- 15 campus-level committees; and
- 16 (2) the selection of community members and business
- 17 representatives to serve on the district-level committee in a
- 18 manner that provides for appropriate representation of the
- 19 community's diversity.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
