## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## 1AN ACT2relating to the inclusion of professional staff who educate3students with disabilities on district-level and campus-level

4 planning and decision-making committees.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subsections (b) and (e), Section 11.251, 7 Education Code, are amended to read as follows:

8 (b) The board shall adopt a policy to establish a district-9 and campus-level planning and decision-making process that will 10 involve the professional staff of the district, parents, and community members in establishing and reviewing the district's and 11 12 campuses' educational plans, goals, performance objectives, and 13 major classroom instructional programs. The board shall establish a procedure under which meetings are held regularly by district-14 15 and campus-level planning and decision-making committees that representative professional staff, 16 include including, if 17 practicable, at least one representative with the primary responsibility for educating students with disabilities, parents 18 of students enrolled in the district, business representatives, and 19 The committees shall include a business 20 community members. 21 representative without regard to whether the representative 22 resides in the district or whether the business the person represents is located in the district. The board, or the board's 23 24 designee, shall periodically meet with the district-level

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committee to review the district-level committee's deliberations. 1 2 (e) The board shall adopt a procedure, consistent with Section 21.407(a), for the professional staff in the district to 3 4 nominate and elect the professional staff representatives who shall meet with the board or the board designee as required under this 5 section. At least two-thirds of the elected professional staff 6 7 representatives must be classroom teachers. The remaining staff representatives shall include both campus- and district-level 8 9 professional staff members. If practicable, the committee <u>membership</u> shall include at least one professional staff 10 representative with the primary responsibility for educating 11 students with disabilities. Board policy must provide procedures 12 13 for:

14 (1) the selection of parents to the district-level and 15 campus-level committees; and

16 (2) the selection of community members and business 17 representatives to serve on the district-level committee in a 18 manner that provides for appropriate representation of the 19 community's diversity.

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
