- 7 notification of rulemaking filings by a state agency [A state
- 8 agency shall deliver to the lieutenant governor and the speaker of
- 9 the house of representatives a copy of the notice of a proposed rule
- 10 when the agency files notice with the secretary of state] under
- 11 Section 2001.023.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
