- 4 SECTION 1. Section 405.017, Government Code, is amended to

- 6 Sec. 405.017. MISCELLANEOUS DUTIES. The secretary of state
- 7 shall:
- 8 (1) affix the state seal to all official documents
- 9 issued from the secretary of state's office;
- 10 (2) unless provided otherwise by law, commission state

- 12 (3) keep [in a separate suitable book] a register of
- 13 all state officers;
- 14 (4) immediately on receipt, deliver to the person in
- 15 charge of the state library all books, maps, charts, printed
- 16 volumes of the laws of a nation, territory, or another state, or
- 17 other political or miscellaneous publications received in the
- 18 secretary of state's office;
- 19 (5) immediately on receipt, deliver to the supreme
- 20 court librarian reports of courts of a nation, territory, or
- 21 another state received in the secretary of state's office; and
- 22 (6) perform such other and further duties as may be
- 23 directed by the governor.
- SECTION 2. Sections 405.019(b) and (c), Government Code,

S.B. No. 792

- 1 are amended to read as follows:
- 2 (b) The secretary of state shall \underline{make} [send] the list
- 3 <u>available</u> to [each of] the county clerks of this state before
- 4 January 1 of each year.
- 5 (c) The secretary of state shall amend the list and $\underline{\text{make}}$
- 6 [immediately send] the amended list available to the county clerks
- 7 of this state if the secretary learns that a state or territory has
- 8 changed its requirements relating to a notary public in a manner
- 9 that requires it to be added to or deleted from the list.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
