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- 2 relating to regulation of nurse aides.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 250, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Section 250.0035 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 250.0035. TRAINING REQUIREMENTS; CONTINUING
- 7 EDUCATION. (a) To be listed on the nurse aide registry, an
- 8 applicant must complete a training program approved by the
- 9 Department of Aging and Disability Services that includes:
- 10 (1) not less than 100 hours of course work as specified
- 11 by rule; and
- 12 (2) a competency evaluation on completion of the
- 13 <u>training program.</u>
- 14 (b) A listing on the nurse aide registry expires on the
- 15 second anniversary of the date of the listing.
- 16 (c) To renew a nurse aide's listing on the registry, the
- 17 nurse aide must complete at least 24 hours of in-service education
- 18 every two years, including training in geriatrics and, if
- 19 applicable, in the care of patients with Alzheimer's disease.
- 20 <u>(d) The executive commissioner of the Health and Human</u>
- 21 Services Commission shall adopt rules as necessary to implement
- 22 this section.
- 23 SECTION 2. (a) The executive commissioner of the Health
- 24 and Human Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to

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- 1 implement Section 250.0035, Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 2 this Act, not later than May 1, 2013.
- 3 (b) Section 250.0035, Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 4 this Act, applies only to an application for initial listing on the
- 5 nurse aide registry or for renewal of a listing on the registry
- 6 filed on or after September 1, 2013. An application filed before
- 7 that date is governed by the law in effect immediately before the
- 8 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 9 effect for that purpose.
- 10 (c) A person listed as a nurse aide on the nurse aide
- 11 registry under Chapter 250, Health and Safety Code, before
- 12 September 1, 2013, is entitled to continue to be included on the
- 13 nurse aide registry without fulfilling any additional educational
- 14 training or evaluation requirements established by the executive
- 15 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission under
- 16 Subsection (a), Section 250.0035, Health and Safety Code, as added
- 17 by this Act, if the person satisfies the other qualifications
- 18 required by the executive commissioner and Chapter 250, Health and
- 19 Safety Code.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
