1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to allowing the Aransas County Commissioners Court to
1-9 charge interest on assessments for certain county road
1-10 improvements.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. This Act is enacted under the authority of the
1-13 legislature to pass local laws for the maintenance of public roads
1-14 and highways under Subsection (e), Section 9, Article VIII, Texas
1-15 Constitution.

1-16 SECTION 2. Section 253.008, Transportation Code, is amended
1-17 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
1-18 follows:

1-19 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the [The]
1-20 commissioners court may not require the payment of interest on an
1-21 assessment.

1-22 (d) The Commissioners Court of Aransas County may require
1-23 the payment of interest on an assessment.

1-24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
