- 17 training, or research occurring within the district for the purpose
- of delivery of health care services to or for the district, provided 18
- that the public institution or charitable organization receiving 19
- the capital or financial contribution does not use any part of the 20
- funding, either directly or indirectly, to provide or refer for 21

- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 23
