Section 281.0565(d), Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 (d) A district created in a county with a population of more 8 9 than 800,000 that was not included in the boundaries of a hospital district before September 1, 2003, may make a capital or other 10 11 financial contribution to: 12 (1) a charitable organization created by the district to provide regional administration and delivery of health care 13 14 services to or for the district; or (2) a charitable organization for the support of 15 16 medical, dental, or clinical education, training, or research occurring within the district for the purpose of delivery of health 17 care services to or for the district. 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22

23 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
