BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Section 281.0565, Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-13

1-14 (d) A district created in a county with a population of more 1**-**15 1**-**16 than 800,000 that was not included in the boundaries of a hospital district before September 1, 2003, may make a capital or other 1-17 financial contribution to:

(1) a charitable organization created by the district to provide regional administration and delivery of health care 1-18 1-19 1-20 1-21 services to or for the district; or

(2) a charitable organization for the support of medical, dental, or clinical education, training, or research 1-22 1-23 occurring within the district for the purpose of delivery of health 1-24

<u>care services to or for the district</u>. <u>SECTION 2.</u> This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-25 1-26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2011. 1-29

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
