## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the enforcement of building code standards for new

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 233, Local Government
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Sections 233.1545 and 233.1546 to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 Sec. 233.1545. FEE. A county may charge a fee not to exceed
- 10 \$125 for each new residential construction project to defray the
- 11 costs of administering the building code requirements of this
- 12 subchapter.
- 13 Sec. 233.1546. CERTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE; CONNECTION OF
- 14 UTILITIES. (a) This section applies only to new residential
- 15 construction of a single-family house or duplex.
- 16 (b) On the written request of a person who builds new
- 17 residential construction subject to this section, the person for
- 18 whom the new residential construction is built, or an entity that
- 19 provides utility service, the commissioners court shall:
- 20 <u>(1) determine</u> whether the new residential
- 21 construction meets all requirements applicable under this
- 22 subchapter; and
- 23 (2) issue the requesting party a written certificate
- 24 of its determination.

- 1 (c) An electric, gas, water, or sewer service utility may
- 2 not serve or connect new residential construction subject to this
- 3 section with electricity, gas, water, sewer, or other utility
- 4 service unless the utility receives a certificate issued by the
- 5 commissioners court under Subsection (b) that states that the new
- 6 residential construction meets all requirements applicable under
- 7 this subchapter.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 233.153(f), Local Government Code, is
- 9 repealed.
- 10 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 11 new residential construction that commences on or after the
- 12 effective date of this Act, except that if the county requires
- 13 notice under Section 233.154(b), Local Government Code, this Act
- 14 applies only to new residential construction for which notice was
- 15 given on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
