- 12 DYSLEXIA. (a) In this section, "dyslexia" has the meaning
- 13 assigned by Section 51.970, Education Code.
- 14 (b) For each licensing examination administered by a state
- 15 agency, the agency shall provide reasonable examination
- 16 accommodations to an examinee diagnosed as having dyslexia.
- 17 <u>(c) Each state agency shall adopt rules necessary to</u>
- 18 implement this section, including rules to establish the
- 19 eligibility criteria an examinee must meet for accommodation under
- 20 <u>this section</u>.
- 21 SECTION 3. (a) Each state agency that offers a licensing
- 22 examination shall adopt rules to implement Section 54.003,
