4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 54, Occupations Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 54. EXAMINATION ON RELIGIOUS HOLY DAY; EXAMINATION
8	ACCOMMODATIONS FOR PERSON WITH DYSLEXIA
9	SECTION 2. Chapter 54, Occupations Code, is amended by
10	adding Section 54.003 to read as follows:
11	Sec. 54.003. EXAMINATION ACCOMMODATIONS FOR PERSON WITH
12	DYSLEXIA. (a) In this section, "dyslexia" has the meaning
13	assigned by Section 51.970, Education Code.
14	(b) For each licensing examination administered by a state
15	agency, the agency shall provide reasonable examination
16	accommodations to an examinee diagnosed as having dyslexia.
17	(c) Each state agency shall adopt rules necessary to
18	implement this section, including rules to establish the
19	eligibility criteria an examinee must meet for accommodation under
20	this section.
21	SECTION 3. (a) Each state agency that offers a licensing
22	examination shall adopt rules to implement Section 54.003,
23	Occupations Code, as added by this Act, not later than December 1,
24	2011.

(b) The change in law made by Section 54.003, Occupations
Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a licensing examination
offered by a state agency on or after January 1, 2012.
