- 6 (b) A trustee of an independent school district required to
- 7 file a financial disclosure statement only because of the amendment
- 8 by this Act of Section 11.064, Education Code, is not required to
- 9 include in the financial disclosure statement financial activity
- 10 occurring before January 1, 2012.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
