## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to compliance with state and federal environmental permits
3	as a defense to certain actions for nuisance or trespass.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 7, Water Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 7.257 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 7.257. DEFENSE TO NUISANCE OR TRESPASS. (a) A
8	person, as defined by Section 382.003, Health and Safety Code, who
9	is subject to an administrative, civil, or criminal action brought
10	under this chapter for nuisance or trespass arising from greenhouse
11	gas emissions has an affirmative defense to that action if the
12	person's actions that resulted in the alleged nuisance or trespass
13	were authorized by a rule, permit, order, license, certificate,
14	registration, approval, or other form of authorization issued by
15	the commission or the federal government or an agency of the federal
16	government and:
17	(1) the person was in substantial compliance with that
18	rule, permit, order, license, certificate, registration, approval,
19	or other authorization while the alleged nuisance or trespass was
20	occurring; or
21	(2) the commission or the federal government or an
22	agency of the federal government exercised enforcement discretion
23	in connection with the actions that resulted in the alleged
24	nuisance or trespass.

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## 1 (b) This section does not apply to nuisance actions related 2 to a noxious odor.

SECTION 2. Section 7.257, Water Code, as added by this Act, 3 applies only to an administrative enforcement action, a civil 4 action, or a prosecution that is commenced on or after the effective 5 date of this Act. An administrative enforcement action, a civil 6 7 action, or a prosecution commenced before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the action or 8 9 prosecution commenced, and that law is continued in effect for that 10 purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
